# **Privacy Statement**

We know your personal information is important to you and it is also important to us.

We collect your personal data to provide virtual assistant services to you. This includes your name, phone number, email address and postal code. Credit card information is not retained.

#### **Data Controls**

#### Why We Collect and Process Your Information

Without collecting and using the information you provide to us or we obtain about you, it would not be possible for us to provide you with our products and/or services.

We use information held about you in the following ways:

# Information you give to us

Information you give to us:

- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered between you and us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;

- To contact you from time to time for market research purposes. We may contact you by email or phone.

## Information we collect about you

### Required by law

We use your personal information to comply with any law and regulations where we are required to do so.

# Our legitimate interest

We use your personal information for our legitimate interests as shown below. We have taken account of any privacy risks and ensured that your data protection rights are not affected. - Training: for virtual assistant and customer service training and compliance purposes;

- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data to comply with any legal obligation, or to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Outsource, its customers or others.

#### **Data Retention Periods**

It is our aim to only hold your data for as long as this is necessary. While you continue as a customer with us we will retain your data as detailed above in this statement. The retention period will be 24 months from the date of termination of our terms of service. We have a high number of customers who re-engage with our service after a period of absence. This retention period allows for the data to be reused where necessary. However, you can send an email to request that your Data is deleted at any time within this period. We will respond to your request and complete the full deletion within 30 days.

Specific legal periods are in place for payments details, tax and invoicing data, and this would be retained in accordance with the law (which is currently six years).

#### Security

We are committed to protecting the security of your personal data. We use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal data from unauthorized access and use. As effective as modern security practices are, no physical or electronic security system is entirely secure. The transmission of information via the internet is also not completely secure. We cannot guarantee the complete security of our databases, nor can we guarantee that information you supply will not be intercepted while being transmitted to us over the Internet. We will continue to revise policies and implement additional security features as new technologies become available.

Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your personal data transmitted to us. Any transmission of data is at your own risk. Once we receive your personal data, we use appropriate security measures to seek to prevent unauthorized access.

### **Your Rights**
